Ames Area USBC Triple Crown Rules

Updated 9-22-25

- 1. The Triple Crown is a program designed to encourage participants in the tournaments hosted by the AAUSBC. The tournaments are Bakers Doubles, 9-pin Trio, and the Association tournament which consists of singles, doubles, and team events.
- 2. The Triple Crown is funded by the AAUSBC and sponsors.
- 3. Prizes are as follows: \$500 for 1st place, \$250 for 2nd place, and \$100 for 3rd place.
- 4. Bowlers must bowl in at least one event in each of the three centers: Carousel Lanes, Perfect Games, and Sports Bowl.
- 5. Bowlers must participate in at least 4 of the 5 handicap tournament events.
- 6. A bowler may participate multiple times in the tournaments as the tournament rules allow.
- 7. Bowlers will earn points by their final finish in each event. 1st place will get 1 point, 2nd place will get 2 points, and so on.
- 8. The best 4 finishes will be used and those points added will determine final placement for the Triple Crown.
- 9. Winners will be notified and prize checks will be written no later than 30 days following the last day of the last tournament.
- 10. Prize checks for the Triple Crown will be presented to the winners during a league of their choice by the AAUSBC.
